## a. Treasurer's Report – Tina McCoy

McCoy asked Councilmembers if they had questions on the Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual Report. There were none.

## 1. Claire Hatfield, City of Hauser Properties – RC&D

### 3. Roger Lefebvre, City Projects – RC&D Alternate

Lefebvre reported his research findings on the Cell Tower project. He said all cell tower companies have their own engineering and survey departments. They find the locations where they want cell towers for business and profit benefits. Then they solicit for cell sites. Soliciting *them* for a cell tower on City property is not the pathway to take. Citizen complaints regarding service or lack thereof need to be registered with the provider so they are aware of gaps of cell coverage and other issues. Lefebvre said he would get contact and phone numbers for the complaints. Mayor Johnston asked if there was another other type of service to get coverage. Fire Chief Simms responded by saying he purchased a "cell phone repeater" for the Fire Department Building but it only gets calls from outside his building to inside, and it is an expensive piece of equipment. It does not improve coverage otherwise. Further description was given by Simms.

### 4. Gary Mallon – Public Works

- Mallon reported he sold one of the trailers. He has had an offer for the truck and possibly the trailer, and that one battery is needed to get the truck running.
- Federal regulations for street signs have changed and all signs must be reflective by 2013. Discussion followed on costs of various signs.

- Mallon said he will be taking the fabric fence down on City property near the swale.
- . The City does not have a working weed eater and Mallon suggested purchasing one.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Disbursements: McCoy said one check needs to be signed, and the Quick Books soft ware needs to be renewed at a cost of approximately \$250.00. Hatfield moved to pay the bills. Mallon seconded the motion. Roll call: Mallon, aye; Hynes, aye; Hatfield, aye; Lefebvre, aye. Motion carried.

Messages would go to your cell phone in text message format so unless a person has unlimited texting, charges may be applied.
